\*When you count, start with one, not a/an. (one book, two books, three books ...)

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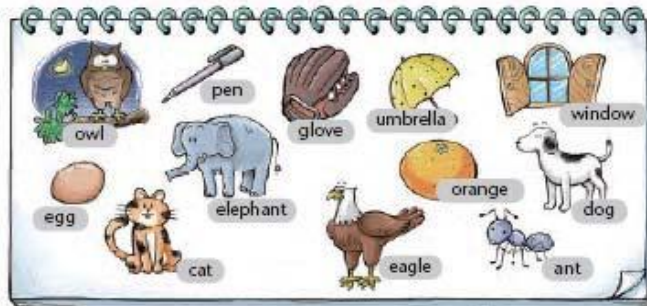
