Some shallow parts of the ocean have coral reefs. Coral looks like a hard, rocky plant. But it's actually a living creature. When millions of coral come together in one area, they create a coral reef. Coral reefs are very important for the oceans.

First, coral reefs provide safe places for fish to live. Large numbers of species of fish often live in the reefs. Predators like sharks can't swim in the reefs, so the fish are safe there. For that reason, many fish lay their eggs in coral reefs. Coral reefs are also rich in food. They are typically found in warm waters. The water around a reef has many nutrients. This provides food for the fish. Unfortunately, people and pollution are destroying coral reefs. People need to take better care of the coral reefs. Then, more fish will be able to live in the ocean.
